

Support services for the development of the German Qualifications Framework

The development of the German Qualifications Framework for Lifelong Learning (DQR) goes back to an initiative of the Education Ministers of the European Union and the European Parliament to create a European Qualifications Framework for Lifelong Learning (EQF). In October 2006, the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) and the Standing Conference of the Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs of the Länder in the Federal Republic of Germany (KMK) agreed on the joint development of a German Qualifications Framework (DQR). The implementation of this project complies with the recommendation of the European Parliament and Council of 23 April 2008, since replaced by the recommendation of the European Council of 22 May 2017.

f-bb's DQR Office is providing support services to BMBF as it develops the DQR. These include preparing content for, organising, and documenting various coordination processes at the national level. f-bb's tasks include research, consultancy, and organisational services for the preparation and monitoring of committee work as well as comparative analyses of vocational education and training (VET) systems in other countries. f-bb analyses DQR-relevant topics across various VET disciplines and participates in the development and maintenance of the DQR qualification database.
