Virtual bridging measures for people with foreign university degrees in psychology (focus: educational psychology and clinical and health psychology)



The "Integration through Qualification (IQ)" seeks to increase the chances of immigrants' finding a position more in line with their existing qualifications and improve their (vocational) integration into life in Germany.

This virtual further education offer is aimed at people who have obtained a university degree in psychology in their home country, but who do not yet have work in Germany that matches their qualifications.

The measure offers participants the opportunity to update their expertise, relate it to the German labour market, and add occupation-specific German language skills. The courses consist of a combination of lessons in the virtual classroom, accompanied learning phases in the learning management system, self-study, and classroom sessions. In addition, participants will be offered e-coaching to help them enter the labour market.

The virtual learning uses the ILIAS learning management system and the Adobe Connect online conferencing system. The course lasts about 22 weeks.

The bridge course concludes with a certificate listing the content learned, the lessons completed, and the participant's performance. This will improve the participants' chances on the German job market.
